## Lower and Middle School

### Girls' Uniform

Black kilt \*

White open neck blouse  
Black V-neck pullover \*  
White ankle socks or black tights  
(*Fine black tights permitted from Year 9*)  
Plain black polished leather shoes  
(*Low heeled, enclosed with no visible  
coloured stitching or labels*)  
White DT apron

### Boys' Uniform

Black trousers  
School blazer \*  
White shirt  
Blue/silver tie (Years 7, 8 & 9)\*  
Maroon crested tie (Years 10 & 11)\*  
Black V-neck pullover \*  
Black or dark grey socks  
Plain black polished leather shoes  
(*no coloured stitching or labels*)  
White DT apron

### Girls' Sports Kit

White polo shirt with badge \*  
Maroon cycle shorts \*  
Maroon PE skirt \*  
Black swimsuit \*  
House hockey shirt \*  
Astro-turf shoes  
Trainers with non-marking soles  
Short white sports socks  
Hockey socks \*  
Navy blue tracksuit with badge \*\*

### Boys' Sports Kit

White polo shirt with badge \*  
White PE shorts  
Black rugby shorts \*  
House rugby shirt \*  
Black swim trunks \*  
Rugby boots (*safety studs must be used*)  
Trainers with non-marking soles  
Short white sports socks  
Rugby socks \*  
Navy blue tracksuit with badge \*\*  
Cricket whites

# Additional Information

- SCARVES** Scarves may be worn to and from school but not in school. Football scarves or similar are not acceptable.
- BAGS** Bags should give adequate protection to books  
Books should not be carried in the same bag as games kit.
- HAIR** Hairstyles should be conventional and neat; no extremes of style or colour will be allowed. Hair should be kept clean and off the face. Girls with long hair should tie their hair back. Boys' hair should not be very short and must be off the jacket collar. Hair accessories for girls should be black or navy blue in colour.
- JEWELLERY** No jewellery whatsoever is allowed apart from a watch and girls in any section of the school may wear one plain gold stud in the lobe of each ear. Regulations for Sixth Form may vary.
- MAKE-UP** Discreet make-up is allowed for Sixth Form girls only. Coloured nail varnish is not allowed.
- OVERCOATS** Overcoats must be of a plain colour and must hang below the bottom edge of the blazer (no coloured emblems or insignia). Fleece tops (including "hoodies") may not be worn.
- SHOES** Shoes should be plain. Trainer-style shoes or fashion shoes should not be worn.
- SKIRTS** Skirt length should be to the knee

## Sixth Form Dress Code

Students are encouraged to wear College colours blazers when they have been awarded

### Boys

Plain dark coloured business suit  
Plain shirt – worn tucked in  
Plain or simple patterned tie or Colours tie  
Plain dark V neck sweater, as required  
Formal, polished black leather shoes

### Girls

Plain dark coloured business suit (trousers or skirt)  
Plain shirt/blouse (no patterns)  
Plain or simple patterned tie – optional  
Plain dark V-neck sweater or cardigan, as required  
Dark coloured (black, blue or brown), formal leather shoes – low heel only

# Senior School Summer Uniform

*The Headmistress will notify the date for the commencement of summer uniform*

## Lower and Middle School Options

### Boys

Full school uniform

**OR**

No blazer or pullover, with tie

**OR**

No blazer or pullover and no tie,  
with shirt sleeves rolled up, and top  
shirt button undone.

### Girls

Full school uniform

**OR**

No blazer with or without pullover

- Shirts and blouses should be tucked in at all times
- Blazers do not have to be brought to school
- Outdoor coats may only be worn with full uniform
- Only those pupils who are being collected from the College by car may wear games kit home following after school practices or fixtures

## Sixth Form Options

- **Boys** may remove jackets (and ties if they wish). If ties are not worn the top shirt button should be undone and shirt sleeves rolled up
- **Girls** may remove jackets. Full-length trousers or knee-length skirts should be worn. Blouses should cover shoulders and midriff
